Sections: Sections enable you to draw 2D cross-sections (2D top, bottom, or side views) of your design. Basic terminology In AutoCAD, a 2D drawing means a two-dimensional representation of any area of a three-dimensional space or shape. A 2D drawing consists of a set of three numbers that define the x, y, and z coordinates for the shape (x, y, z). The x, y, and z coordinates are measured as "lines" from a starting point to an ending point, the endpoint being a specific reference point (the z coordinate). The z coordinate can also be referred to as a "height" or "thickness," and the x, y, and z coordinates are collectively called the "ruler." (See the table on the next page.) The x and y coordinates are typically measured in feet (0.3048 m) or meters, although AutoCAD also has inches (0.0254 m) and other units. The z coordinate is measured in inches or meters, depending on which coordinate system you are using. In AutoCAD, a drawing has three properties: Type, Size, and Status. Type: The Type property determines whether you are using a plan, an elevation, or a section. The Size property determines the file size. A drawing that is larger than the specified size will use a new file (drawing). A drawing that is

The problem is that those divs are added into the DOM after it is created, so the first thing I tried to do was to append a string to the div, but that didn't work. Then I tried to addClass to the div when it's created, but that didn't work. I found something that might work if I could add an id to the div, but then I lose the ability to add on click functions.
